General Description:

Primary Responsibilities:

3. Oversee preaching schedules and worship service planning.
4. Develop and communicate with the elders the vision of the church.
5. Champion a healthy and flourishing staff culture.

Secondary Responsibilities:

1. Train and develop new and existing leaders.
2. Lead in ministry training and calling, equipping lay members for ministry.
3. Serve as a compassionate pastoral model and a prophetic voice.
4. Participate and provide assistance in Restoration brotherhood ministry events promoting fellowship and unity. Work with community ministries to grow the Kingdom of God.
5. Provide spiritual leadership to the church, its chosen leaders, ministers, and staff.
6. Work with the elders for the purpose of oversight, direction, and guidance of the church.
7. Lead or participate in a LIFE Group.
8. Other duties and responsibilities as agreed.
