RESPONSIBILITIES

This job description is written for 25 hours per week, but the areas of responsibility in this position can be adapted to suit the gifts and schedule of applicants who do not have 25 hours available.

- Collaborate with the Cityview Campus Minister to plan and lead Sunday morning worship services with creativity, integrity, devotion, and honesty.
- Schedule and pastor music volunteers.
- Empower volunteers and build teams to support the ministry and help volunteers to grow in discipleship.
- Assume responsibility for the function and capability of our A/V Tech systems.
- Recruit, direct, schedule, train, and pastor volunteers for serving with A/V Tech.
- Schedule Cityview Campus Sunday morning set-up volunteers.
- Work closely with the Grandview Minister of Worship Arts to lead worship in most whole-church events throughout the year (Two4Two, Christmas Eve, Ash Wednesday, Palm Sunday, Easter, other special events).
- Participate in the life of the church through worship and attendance at regular church gatherings.
- Utilize the planning, scheduling, communication, and administration tools available through Planning Center, Microsoft Office suite, Outlook, Teams, and Church Media Squad.
- Schedule and lead any necessary musical rehearsals.
- Communicate with staff using a report or the weekly all staff meeting.
- Communicate with elders using a monthly report.
- Participate in the weekly Cityview Campus team meeting.
